Trump's whirlwind first 100 days see admin notch wins amidst turbulence on various fronts

actions have been varied, but going unnoticed isn't one of them.

President Donald Trump's second term has marked one of the busiest first 100 days of any president in recent memory, with the commander-in-chief issuing a slew of executive orders and pursuing a litany of initiatives designed to radically overhaul the federal government, upending the four-year legacy of his predecessor. The initiatives may also have a profound effect on how Americans define themselves.

Though Trump's early period back in office has been moderately less battle-scarred than the Napoleonic Hundred Days, his return has nonetheless heightened anxieties in the nation's governing and financial capitals, roiled markets, and placed tens of thousands of federal workers in employment limbo. The 100-day milestone, though somewhat arbitrary, has been the typical benchmark for assessing a president's initial rollout of their policy priorities.

Prior to Trump, President Franklin Delano Roosevelt held a clear record for the most aggressive 100 days as he unveiled an impressive string of executive orders and initiatives aimed at combating the Great Depression, mostly referred to as "The New Deal."

Trump plans to tout his 100-day achievements at an event in Michigan on Tuesday. "The next 100 days will consist of trade deals, peace deals, and tax cuts. More American greatness is on the way," White House press secretary Karoline Leavitt said, according to The Washington Post.

"In his first 100 days, President Trump has delivered on hundreds of promises and already accomplished his two most important campaign goals — the border is secure and inflation is ending," Leavitt said.

Historian Sir Niall Ferguson said succinctly in The Free Press: "Donald Trump is crushing his to-do list."

Justice Dept. civil rights office reshaped by Trump, prompting exodus

QUOTE: The new head of the Justice Department’s civil rights division is dramatically reshaping the office to propel President Donald Trump’s social agenda, prompting the departure of about half of the division’s lawyers in recent weeks, according to people familiar with the situation and public statements from top officials.

Since being sworn in this month, civil rights director Harmeet K. Dhillon has redirected her staff to focus on combating antisemitism, anti-Christian bias, the participation of transgender athletes in women’s sports and what Trump and his allies have described as Democrats’ “woke ideology.”

The division changed mission statements across its sections to focus less on racial discrimination and more on fighting diversity initiatives and what the administration sees as bias against Christians. And department officials reassigned more than a dozen career staffers — including section chiefs overseeing police brutality, disability and voting rights cases — to areas outside of their legal expertise.

The changes under Dhillon, coincide with a second White House offer to federal workers that allows them to resign from their positions and be paid through September. The deadline for that offer is late Monday evening, and civil rights employees have been submitting their resignations en masse as the deadline neared. People familiar with the operations of the division who spoke on the condition of anonymity because of the sensitivity of the matter.

More than 100 division attorneys have already said they will leave their jobs, Dhillon told conservative podcaster Glenn Beck during an appearance on his show Saturday. Many departed because they disagree with the division's new direction, she said.

The division had around 380 attorneys when Trump began his second term in the White House. Approximately half have left, according to people familiar with the division, and Dhillon told Beck she had no problem with their departures.

The massive amount of lawfare being waged against the Trump Administration and the willingness of activist, leftist federal judges to facilitate what in many cases are illegitimate, frivolous efforts to frustrate President Trump's agenda are concerning. Efforts are underway in Congress to rein in some of the radical injunctions issued by leftist courts (I wrote about this and other ways to challenge the out-of-control federal judiciary in an article in March 2025). Additionally, the United States Supreme Court recently agreed to hear three cases involving President Trump's birthright citizenship Executive Order. One of the issues for SCOTUS to review in those cases is the propriety of nationwide injunctions being issued by district courts. (I also previously wrote about birthright citizenship for anyone interested more on that subject.) Progress is slowly but surely being made on this front.

Meanwhile, the Trump Administration continues to score wins in the litigation. Those wins are strengthening the Presidency and the Trump Administration's ability to implement policy. And the wins will keep coming, make no mistake about it.

Prominent pollster blasts colleagues for skewing Trump's 100 Days approval

QUOTE: Big Data Poll director Richard Baris is blasting fellow pollsters for declaring that President Donald Trump's first 100 days in office were being perceived poorly by voters, suggesting some in the industry were skewing data to reflect their bias.

"We saw a slew of polling before the election, including pollsters that came out over the weekend with the 100-day narrative, and they were all wrong," Baris told the Monday edition of the "Just the News, No Noise" TV show.

According to an ABC News/Washington Post/Ipsos poll, 55% of Americans say they disapprove of Trump's first 100 days in office.

In a CNN poll, Trump only has a 41% approval rating for his first 100 days.

"People are hearing the media narrative, and they're seeing the Friday night headlines, and it's meant to cause panic. And so they are reacting to that with so many of the other polls," Baris said. "But when you get a little bit more granular, and you ask people whether or not they think this strategy could pay off, and if it does, is it worth it? Then we're getting very different answers."

Baris said some pollsters were wrong during the 2024 election and are wrong now with how they are doing their polling. He specifically said he was concerned poll samples were under measuring Trump supporters.

"I'm looking at their numbers, and they're interestingly, about five to seven point off of the rest of us who actually have polled elections correctly," he said. "And that's about how far they were wrong in 2024. So it's like nothing has changed."

Trump to sign sweeping orders targeting sanctuary cities, backing police

QUOTE: President Trump signed executive orders Monday to target sanctuary jurisdictions and support cops and police departments accused of wrongdoing.

Trump has called for defunding cities and states that won't cooperate to deport illegal immigrants and his orders will heap on additional pressure.

The executive order on sanctuary jurisdictions "direct[s] the attorney general [Patrick] Bondi] and also [Homeland Security Secretary] Kristi Noem... to provide a list of sanctuary cities in which local officials are not complying with this federal order and are not complying with federal immigration laws," White House press secretary Karoline Leavitt said at a morning briefing. The other order, billed as promoting "law and order," calls for authorities to "pursue legal action against state or local officials obstructing criminal or immigration law enforcement," according to a document outlining its contents.

The second order also contains a broader set of reforms, including instructing the Justice Department to “create a mechanism to provide legal resources and indemnification for officers facing unjust expenses from official duties, including bono assistance.”
