Top 27 Revelations in the Fauci Diaries

QUOTE: The combined files necessary to unravel the COVID era—the actors, the motivations, the many moving parts—run into the hundreds of thousands of pages. Confusing and convoluted does not quite describe them. One way to conceptualize the fullness of the issue is to focus on the most remarkable document yet, the diaries of Anthony Fauci, now called the diaries.

They were kept on government computers. Their preparation was assisted by government employees. By law, the results belong to the public. And yet it is obvious that these notes were a first draft of what he hoped would be his autobiography. These were left behind when he retired from public service in December 2022.

Fauci Texts Reveal Concerns About COVID Vaccines and Miscarriages.

QUOTE: Newly released text messages show that Dr. Anthony Fauci privately discussed potential concerns about mRNA COVID-19 vaccines for pregnant women in January 2021, including whether fever and cytokine-related symptoms following a second dose could theoretically increase the risk of miscarriage during the first trimester. The exchange involved Fauci, then-CDC Director Dr. Rochelle Walensky and Dr. Vivek Murthy, who later served as U.S. Surgeon General, according to documents released by Senators Ron Johnson (R-WI) and Rand Paul (R-KY).

Murthy initially asked whether vaccination should be given earlier or later in pregnancy and whether officials had identified adverse outcomes among vaccinated pregnant women. Fauci responded that there was no data or theoretical basis to favor vaccination at one stage of pregnancy over another and rejected concerns that mRNA vaccines could alter human genes, but later raised possibility that fever after a second dose could theoretically be associated with miscarriage in the first trimester.

Walensky acknowledged the concern, while Murthy said he had also heard concerns about potential effects on developing babies.

The senators said the messages could have implications for public health and informed consent, while noting that the large collection of records, including roughly 34,000 text messages and 522 voicemails, remained under review.

The release of these messages raises questions about transparency and whether proper informed consent was provided to pregnant women regarding vaccine risks.

Massachusetts Governor Maura Healey Signs Bill for Abortions Up to Birth

QUOTE: Massachusetts Governor Maura Healey has signed H.5595, which would legalize abortions up to birth.

The radical bill that allows abortions up until birth even on healthy unborn babies. Democrats fast tracked the measure to bypass the full committee process so the body could pass the bill before the legislature adjourned.

The bill passed the overwhelmingly Democrat House on July 22 by a vote of 119. Under current state law, abortions are allowed up to 24 weeks of pregnancy, although weak exceptions essentially allow it up to birth.

Abortions after that point are permitted only when the mother's life or health is threatened (which could mean anything), or if the baby is unlikely to survive outside the womb. The new bill shifts the criteria for late-term abortions from that list of specific medical conditions to a more flexible standard based solely on the abortionist approving the abortion.

It would allow abortions to be carried out on babies at any gestational age after 24 weeks for any reason.

“Governor Healey and the Massachusetts Legislature have erased the final protections for unborn children who can feel pain and who could survive outside the womb,” said Carol Tobias, president of National Right to Life. “At the very sta when premature babies are receiving lifesaving care in neonatal intensive care ur Massachusetts will permit abortionists to end the lives of children of the same ag —and even older. That is not compassion, and it is not health care.”

Trump's Executive Order on Vaccines — What Does It Mean?

QUOTE: An executive order signed Monday by President Donald Trump has ram up the national debate over childhood vaccines. The order calls for sweeping changes to U.S. vaccine policy, including reducing the number of diseases for wh kids receive routine childhood vaccines and upholding parental and religious rig

Dr. Jane Orient, executive director of the Association of American Physicians and Surgeons, said the executive order "is a positive step and will stimulate a lot of debate that is now being squelched."

But aside from symbolizing the administration's support for health and medical freedom, and rekindling public debate over potential risks associated with routin childhood vaccines, questions remain as to the extent to which the executive ord is enforceable and its ability to lead to tangible changes to U.S. vaccine policy.

Trump's executive order calls on states to harmonize their policies with a U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) study showing that the current 18-disease childhood vaccination schedule requires more vaccinations than othe high-income countries in Europe and Asia.

The executive order also asks states to consider updating their school vaccinatio laws to reflect the new recommendations and advises federal agencies to incorporate the new guidance in their policies.

Brian Hooker, Ph.D., CHD's chief scientific officer, said the order "is filled with so many positive steps toward ending the chronic disease epidemic in the United States" — an issue that previous administrations "kicked down the road for over years."

Writing on his blog, attorney Rick Jaffe said the executive order is a "big deal" w looking at the "big picture," but its impact may be limited in the short term. Jaffe told The Defender that executive orders "do not have the force of law." Instead, i

"state governments that decide mandatory school vaccination." This means that executive order has "little to no immediate operative effect."

Changes to the CDC's recommended childhood vaccination schedule or to state-level policies have also been hampered by judicial challenges.

For Michael Kane, CHD's director of advocacy, the executive order is significant as it was signed during the lead-up to this year's congressional midterm elections.

"The biggest thing about this executive order is that it was signed on a Monday at the height of election season," Kane said. "That means the vaccine issue has been greenlit by the GOP as one that is going to help them in the midterm elections.

What we are seeing is that medical freedom is now a mainstream Republican issue.

Inside Dem Dark Money Campaign To Harass Their Own Female Nominee Until She Quits

QUOTE: Democrats in Montana have embarked on a desperate campaign to force their own U.S. Senate nominee to quit the race, and they're willing to harass members of her family to make that happen.

According to Washington Reporter editor-in-chief Matthew Foldi, Democrats have become increasingly aware that independent candidate Seth Bodnar would stand a much better chance against the Republican nominee, Kurt Alme, a former U.S. Attorney backed by President Donald Trump.

The only person standing in the way is Alani Bankhead — who won the Democratic Party's five-way primary on June 2 with 43.7% of the vote — and the party appears ready and willing to throw out more than 48,000 votes to force a more favorable general election matchup. The goal of the "project," according to a series of screenshots Foldi shared, was to make the Montana Senate seat — and thus potential control of the upper chamber — "more winnable" by convincing Bankhead to drop out of the race.

A call to arms sent out to activist groups around the state suggested that it was an "all hands on deck" situation because Bankhead, who had not responded to "gentler nudges," had to drop out by August 10 in order to be taken off the ballot.

"Democrats want to push Bankhead out of the race in favor of 'independent' candidate Seth Bodnar, who is backed by Chuck Schumer and former senator Jon Tester. These documents offer an inside look at how Democrats' dark money apparatus will use any means, including intimidation to secure their preferred nominee," Foldi posted, following that with a screenshot of a document titled, "Montana Senate Seat: How to Help."

It urges Democrats "who have relevant relationships" to urge Bankhead to drop out of the race.

Anyone with “relevant relationships” — meaning those who might have the ability to put pressure on Bankhead either directly or indirectly — was encouraged to use them to “encourage” Bankhead to exit the race ahead of the August 10 deadline. The document even included a list of people close to the candidate who could be targeted by their pressure campaign. The list included several family members, close friends, as well as current and former campaign staffers.

Just one week prior, up against a nearly identical deadline, South Dakota Democratic Senate nominee Julian Beaudion withdrew from the race, citing a similar pressure campaign orchestrated by left-wing activists who pushed him out in favor of former Democrat-turned-independent Brian Bengtson.

Beaudion explained just after he exited the race that he’d done so in light of a recent “devastating house fire” — the cause of which is still under investigation — and “intimidating threats to drop out of this race.” “The mental and physical safety of my family is my priority and for this reason alone, I step aside,” he said.
