Trump Announces \$500 Obamacare Rebate Checks

QUOTE: President Donald Trump on Thursday said he is providing \$500 rebate checks to nearly 1 million people who he said were "wrongly overcharged" through the Affordable Care Act, or Obamacare.

"Our administration is doing the right thing and giving the money back to the people who were wrongly ripped off," Trump said in a video address released through the White House's X account.

Trump added that those Americans were forced to pay hundreds of millions of dollars under the previous administration. He also chided Democrats for backing major insurance companies.

The check will be "sent to their home address" in the near future, the president added.

Trumo Promises \$5.000 'Trumo Dividend' for Everv American Adult if

GOP Wins Midterms.

QUOTE: President Donald J. Trump announced a plan to distribute \$5,000 to every American adult if the GOP retains control of the House of Representatives and the Senate in the upcoming midterm elections. This proposal, dubbed the “Trump Dividend,” aims to boost the GOP’s electoral prospects.

The proposed payments, unveiled at the ongoing GOP midterms conference in Dallas, Texas, on Wednesday night, could likely cost over \$1 trillion and would require congressional approval. Trump likened the payments to corporate dividends, citing economic success, with Vice President JD Vance subsequently describing the policy as a “dividend for American workers,” potentially funded by tariffs.

Trump previously proposed a \$2,000 dividend earlier this year. He has a history of promoting dividends for the wider public to give them a personal stake in policies such as government efficiency savings and tariffs, as well as a \$1,776 “warrior dividend” for military members last year.

America's Manufacturing Boom Is Real

QUOTE: Don't look now, but profits, hiring and pay packages are booming in the manufacturing sector.

In the first half of last year, the manufacturing employment and production numbers were lame – and many rightly or wrongly blamed the Trump tariffs.

But since the summer of 2025 we've seen a dramatic reversal of fortune for factory production.

Profits are genuinely booming for manufacturers.

The second quarter saw a 22% increase of \$64.2 billion and an eye-popping 67% increase of \$143.8 billion from the second quarter last year.

Census Bureau data show that profits were trending down under Biden and recovered sharply when Trump came back, accelerating since the passage of the Big Beautiful Tax Bill that made business expensing and other key tax provisions retroactive to the beginning of 2025 and

NRCC Adds 5 Candidates to Battleground House Program

QUOTE: The House Republican campaign arm added five candidates in Florida and North Carolina to its battleground program Tuesday as the party works to defend its narrow majority and target Democrat-held seats in November.

National Republican Congressional Committee Chairman Richard Hudson, R-N.C., announced that Dan Green, Mike Beltran, Casey Askar, Scott Singer, and Jennifer Balkcom are joining the committee's MAGA Majority program, according to a statement from the organization.

The additions bring the program to 27 candidates.

The program, formerly known as the NRCC's Young Guns program, provides selected Republican candidates with campaign resources, strategic assistance, and increased visibility. The NRCC says it is focused on candidates running in competitive districts who support President Donald Trump's agenda.

The committee has steadily expanded the MAGA Majority roster throughout the year, adding candidates in states including California, Michigan, Nevada, New York, Ohio, and Texas.

The latest additions also follow the NRCC's removal of New York state Sen. Peter Oberacker from the program. Oberacker, who is challenging Democrat Rep. Josh Riley, came under scrutiny over a decade-old social media post honoring his German grandfather, who served in the Nazi military during World War II.

Scott Bessent Announces Automatic Enrollment in Trump Accounts

QUOTE: Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent said that automatic enrollment was coming for Trump Accounts to make every American child under 18 eligible.

Bessent said the rollout of Trump Accounts — tax-advantaged investment accounts created in the Working Families Tax Cuts — was “going great,” and enrollment has already reached over 7 million since the formal launch in July 2026.

He alluded to making an announcement at the end of the month that would create a spike in the enrollment figures, then he made a breaking news announcement that automatic enrollment was coming. This is projected to push the enrollment up to 70 million, and Bessent added that activation would be still be required for eligible accounts.

“Thirty-eight percent of American households have no stake in our great equity markets, and everyone should. I think everyone should have a piece of the action,” he said. “People who have worked and saved and have a stake in the economy and participate in the market aren’t going to want to bring it down.”

Phelim McAleer and Ann McElhinney Announce \$10,000 Prize for Young Citizen Journalists to Break Stories ‘Everyone Else Missed’

QUOTE: Award-winning journalists and filmmakers Phelim McAleer and

Ann McElhinney announced the creation of a \$10,000 prize for young citizen journalists who pursue truth and uncover groundbreaking stories.

The married couple, who wrote a play about the horrific October 7 terrorist attacks and produced the film *My Son Hunter*, among other highly influential investigative works, announced the Shillman Journalism Prize through their organization, the Unreported Story Society. The pair are looking for a story "the mainstream media won't tell."

"You don't need us to tell you something is broken. Every day, too many real stories of real importance are ignored, because they don't fit the 'narrative.' Or the stories are misreported to hide the truth," the award website reads. "But journalism no longer belongs to legacy newsrooms."

"The future stories that will shape our country are emerging from new spaces. They come from students, citizens, and independent writers who are hungry for the truth. And are willing to do the work. The Shillman Journalism Prize exists to find these stories ... and the people bold enough to tell them," the announcement continues.

The Shillman Prize, which is funded by a grant from Doctor Bob Shillman and The Shillman Foundation, is open to people under the age of 25 who are not employed full-time as a journalist and are living legally in the U.S.

Trump Boosts Veterans' Support and Job Opportunities.

QUOTE: President Donald J. Trump signed an Executive Order on Tuesday to modernize data management and sharing between the Departments of War and Veterans Affairs (VA), expediting veterans' access to benefits. The order mandates the use of secure digital tools, including artificial intelligence (AI), to streamline applications and ensure real-time sharing of military and medical records.

The Executive Order addresses longstanding inefficiencies in transferring records, which currently take 90 to 180 days, delaying veterans' access to healthcare, education, and job training. It also aims to improve the Transition Assistance Program by providing career guidance and connecting service members to specialists who can assist with benefit applications.

In his first term, President Trump implemented policies to reduce VA healthcare wait times, eliminate application backlogs, and provide mental health resources for transitioning veterans.

Trump Admin to Invest \$1.9 Billion in Restarting Shuttered Nuclear Plant to Power AI Boom.

QUOTE: The U.S. Energy Department announced a \$1.9 billion loan to assist in restarting the Duane Arnold nuclear power plant in Iowa, which ceased operations in 2020. This initiative is part of a broader effort to revive nuclear energy in the United States, in part to power the boom in artificial intelligence (AI) data centers.

NextEra Energy, the company behind the project, plans to refurbish the plant's reactor and aims to restart operations by 2029. The federal loan is expected to lower financing costs for NextEra, which has also secured a deal with Google to purchase a portion of the plant's electricity for its data centers.

This move could bolster U.S. nuclear energy capabilities and contribute to energy security, while also supporting tech companies' growing electricity needs.

"Duane Arnold is exactly the kind of investment that will help restore American nuclear leadership, strengthen our energy security, and deliver the affordable, reliable power Americans need to fuel our nation's future," said Greg Beard, director of the Energy Department's loan office.

The Duane Arnold plant originally came online in 1974 but was shut down in 2020 after storm damage. The decision to close was influenced by economic factors, including low natural gas prices and stagnant electricity demand at the time.

Trump EPA Takes Transformative Approach to Ending Plague of Plastic Waste

QUOTE: The Environmental Protection Agency under President Donald Trump has launched a quiet revolution in the approach the EPA takes toward some forms of plastic waste, removing regulatory barriers by treating some plastic recycling as a form of manufacturing rather than waste disposal. The EPA's new approach aims to incentivize advanced recycling of plastic, contributing to the economy while addressing the spread of plastic waste into oceans and other ecosystems.

The EPA under Trump and Administrator Lee Zeldin "has taken several concrete steps to reinvigorate recycling in the United States, including actions that directly support the advanced recycling industry," the agency said in a statement.

Applying different regulations for the same technology can incentivize innovation and growth. The distinction can affect permitting costs, investment decisions, and whether a technology scales commercially.

When asked about the large amount of trash Americans produce, the EPA acknowledged that local governments struggle to adequately handle this "significant activity."

Yet the EPA highlighted that "the challenge presents an opportunity: by prioritizing resource recovery, we can transform waste into valuable materials, reduce environmental impacts, and support a more circular economy."

The Trump EPA is betting that the best way to reduce waste is not merely to regulate it, but to make it worth something. That's a transformation both Republicans and Democrats should be able to get behind.

Ex-forensic crime analyst sentenced 10 years in prison for manipulating DNA data

QUOTE: A judge sentenced a former forensic analyst for the Colorado Bureau of Investigation to 10 years in prison on Tuesday after authorities said her manipulation of DNA data raised questions about the validity of hundreds of criminal cases.

Yvonne "Missy" Woods pleaded guilty in June to perjury, attempting to influence a public servant, forgery and committing a cybercrime. Dozens of other counts were dismissed as part of a plea agreement.

Problems with the scientist's work were found in cases involving homicide, sexual assault, robbery and other crimes, according to authorities.

Prosecutors were forced to review hundreds of cases, and at least one murder conviction was vacated as a result of Woods' misconduct.

Authorities accused her of altering data to conceal tampering, deleting data that showed she failed to troubleshoot issues within the testing process, and not thoroughly documenting tests performed in case records.

"For many years I was entrusted with evidence that could have profound consequences for defendants, victims, families and the courts. I failed that responsibility. I am deeply sorry for that failure," she said.

The investigation into Woods' misconduct began in September 2023 after an intern at the bureau discovered missing information in a case that Woods handled in 2018.

State officials have said that the response to Woods' actions could end up costing more than \$11 million.
