World Trade Surged by 4.4% in 2025 Despite Tariffs

QUOTE: Global trade volumes climbed sharply in 2025 despite sweeping U.S. tariffs defying widespread predictions that higher duties would choke off cross-border commerce.

The volume of goods traded worldwide rose 4.4% in 2025, accelerating from 2.5% growth in 2024, according to data from the Netherlands Bureau for Economic Policy Analysis (CPB). The rebound came even after President Donald Trump imposed country-specific tariffs last spring.

The strength surprised many forecasters.

Shortly after the tariff rollout, the World Trade Organization had projected that global trade would contract in 2025. Instead, trade expanded as supply chains adjusted, tariff rates were later reduced in several cases, and relatively few U.S. trading partners escalated retaliation.

Bank of England Governor Andrew Bailey told U.K. lawmakers that the feared damage did not fully materialize.

"The world economy in terms of activity and trade was more robust than we feared it would be," Bailey said. "Some of the tariffs have not been as big as some of the announcements. World trade has adjusted. There has been an offsetting positive effect from AI."

The CPB data show that China and much of Asia were major beneficiaries.

Chinese exports jumped 8.5% in 2025, while advanced Asian economies excluding Japan — including Taiwan — saw overseas shipments surge 15.9%. Europe's exports slipped modestly but remained resilient overall.

Economists point to several factors explaining why tariffs didn't stall growth. The United States continued to post solid domestic growth and import demand. U.S. GDP expanded at a healthy pace of 2.2% in 2025, and global manufacturing activity stabilized, helping sustain trade volumes even amid policy uncertainty.

Treasury Ends IRS, Fiscal Service Union Deals

QUOTE: The Treasury Department has terminated its collective bargaining agreement with unionized workers employed at the Internal Revenue Service, the agency said Friday, in an escalation of President Donald Trump's push to exert m control over the federal workforce.

Workers at the IRS and the fiscal service bureau, which processes payments for tl government, are represented by the National Treasury Employees Union. They w informed by agency leadership that Treasury terminated their collective bargaini agreements, using an executive order President Donald Trump signed last March the authority for the terminations.

In a letter to IRS workers Friday, IRS Chief Human Capital Officer Alex Kweskin to employees the move "deepens our commitment of operating as one IRS, a collaborative team focused on serving American taxpayers."

The contract terminations come after Scott Kupor, director of the Office of Personnel Management, issued a memo this month to agency heads calling on them to comply with Trump's March order and notify labor unions "that they are terminating any applicable CBAs (collective bargaining agreements), whether represented by the National Treasury Employees Union (NTEU) or another labor union."

The union had sued the federal government last year over Trump's executive ord

And while a Washington, D.C., court issued a preliminary injunction against the government, that was stayed pending an appeal.

Meanwhile, a three-judge panel of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 9th Circuit issued a decision in a separate case Thursday that cleared the way for the implementation of Trump's executive order.

The National Treasury Employees Union represents roughly 150,000 employees in 37 departments and agencies.

Hegseth Halts War Department Study at Elite Schools

QUOTE: Secretary of War Pete Hegseth announced Friday the cancellation of all Department of War attendance at several elite universities beginning in the 2026-2027 academic year.

The move represents an escalation of his criticism of higher education institutions and vowing a broader overhaul of military education.

Hegseth said a prior decision involving Harvard would apply to schools including Princeton, Columbia, MIT, Brown, and Yale.

"Today, just like we did with Harvard, I am ordering the complete and immediate cancellation of all Department of War attendance at institutions like Princeton,

Columbia, MIT, Brown, Yale and many others, starting next academic year, 2026-2027," Hegseth said.

"We cannot and will not continue to send our most capable officers, senior officers into graduate programs that undermine the very values they have sworn to uphold," he added.

The announcement marks a significant shift in policy.

U.S. military officers have long attended civilian universities, including Ivy League and other top-tier institutions, for graduate-level education in national security, public policy, and related disciplines as part of their professional development.

Hegseth concluded with a direct message to service members, contrasting their mission with what he described as skepticism from academic elites.

"As a final message to our warriors, the Ivy League faculty lounges may loathe you, the so-called elite of academia may mock your patriotism and disdain your sacrifice, but never forget that we the War Department have your back," he said.

Ken Paxton Secures 'First-of-Its-Kind' Antitrust Settlement Against Vanguard and ESG Practices.

QUOTE: Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton (R) announced that the Vanguard Group has agreed to a "first-of-its-kind settlement"—effectively ending its defense in a multi-state antitrust lawsuit targeting the company along with BlackRock and State Street, alleging coordinated environmental, social, and governance (ESG)-driven market manipulation. The decision by Vanguard to settle the case likely signals significant trouble for the asset management company's former co-defendants, and, according to Paxton's office, could mark a final ruling that "fundamentally resets the precedent for the conduct of large institutional investors."

"I am glad to see that Vanguard has chosen to protect investors and become the industry leader when it comes to empowering investors with proxy voting choice. This sets a new standard for institutional investors that every company should follow," Paxton said, adding, "While Vanguard has taken appropriate action to resolve this case, BlackRock and State Street have continued to ignore state laws,

engage in anticompetitive schemes that hurt American energy, and undermine those who use their services to invest.”

The antitrust litigation centers around allegations that “a BlackRock-led cartel that sought to drive up the price of coal under the guise of ‘green energy,’” and that “BlackRock’s efforts produced massive profits for itself and its co-conspirators and raised the prices of electricity on consumers throughout the United States.” The Texas Attorney General’s office further asserts that “To further profit on the backs of Americans, BlackRock also deceived thousands of its investors who elected to invest in non-ESG funds.”
