Texas Orders Unauthorized Dallas-Area Muslim 'University' to Cease Operation Immediately

QUOTE: Governor Greg Abbott has directed the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) to order the immediate shutdown of an unauthorized Muslim "university" operating in the Dallas suburb of Richardson.

The fake "university," calling itself the "Texas American Muslim University at Dallas" has been marketing and enrolling students in degree programs, including master's degrees in Artificial Intelligence and bachelor's programs in computer science, IT cybersecurity, and health informatics, without state approval.

The school openly promoted that roughly 30 percent of its curriculum consists of mandatory Islamic studies courses, billing itself as "the first university in the USA to offer STEM degree programs embedded with mandatory courses in Islamic Studies."

On Thursday, the THECB issued a formal cease-and-desist letter demanding that the institution immediately "cease advertising, offering, and enrolling students in degrees or programs of study" and stop using protected terms such as "university."

THECB's letter warns of severe consequences for continued violations, including criminal punishment, administrative penalties, civil penalties, injunctive relief, and liability under the Texas Deceptive Trade Practices Act.

The institution was given until Friday to confirm in writing that it had "voluntarily and permanently, and immediately ceased" all prohibited activities.

DHS Wins 80,000 ‘Voluntary Departure’ Cases

QUOTE: (Radical left public relations form)The Washington Post is lamenting the “voluntary departure” of more than 80,000 economic migrants amid stepped-up pressure from the Department of Homeland Security (DHS).

“Judges issued more than 80,000 voluntary departure orders from January 2025 through March of this year ... [to migrants] who request to leave on their own terms while giving up the opportunity to seek a new life in the U.S.,” the newspaper reported on May 8.

The numbers were provided by the Vera Institute of Justice, a pro-migration group whose federal funding was cut in 2025. They are also another sign of progress in the administration’s myriad small and large efforts to block migration and speed deportations, amid furious opposition from elite-backed pro-migration groups.

The Post’s report continued: The number of people abandoning their immigration cases [for example, asylum claims] is at least seven times as high as the number seen in the last 15 months of the Biden administration, when 11,400 took that

option. More than 70 percent of those granted a voluntary departure order during President Donald Trump's second administration were being held in immigration detention when they made the request, a far higher share than those who departed willingly while Joe Biden was in the White House.

Business lobbies and progressives are pushing for a Democratic victory in the November midterm elections that may help them slow deportations in 2027.

In contrast, Trump's deputies are amping up the deportations, as citizens prefer.

"Just yesterday, we arrested over 1,900 individuals," Homeland Security Chief Markwayne Mullin said on May 5, adding, "We have over 60,000 individuals that currently being detained, going through the process of being deported. Last week we deported over 2,700 [per day]."

Why Oil-Rich Alberta May Secede From Canada

QUOTE: Last week, a separatist group in the oil-rich Canadian province of Alberta located just above Montana, submitted over 300,000 signatures in support of a referendum to leave Canada. That's nearly double the amount of signatures required to trigger a vote by law. Recent reporting shows that at least one quarter of the province's population would vote to leave Canada. While the separatists still have substantial gains to make, the popularity of the movement illustrates a growing list of fractures and faults in Canada's constitutional order—particularly cultural differences, economic grievances, and the systemic political underrepresentation of western provinces.

The origins of the province's first settlers are telling. Albertans have always had a different culture and different ideals from the francophones and monarchists in the east. Early migrants to Alberta included Mormons, Germans, Ukrainians, and other Eastern Europeans, most of whom immigrated north from the United States, rather than from better-settled parts of Canada. They were aspiring Americans who, after riding the long trails from Ellis Island to the Rocky Mountains, chased opportunity north, where land was cheaper and easier to acquire.

And these cultural differences remain, especially in the province's conservative political tendencies.

Compounding these cultural differences is Alberta's unique economic position within Canada. Beneath Alberta's surface lies approximately 167 billion barrels of reserves, nearly four times the volume in the United States. But Alberta is one of only two landlocked provinces in Canada, meaning it cannot get this oil to the international market absent the cooperation of other provinces.

Economic issues have contributed to Canada's steady economic decline over the past 10 years of liberal party rule. The nation now has a lower gross domestic product per capita than Alabama, one of the least productive U.S. states.

It's uncertain how and when the separation referendum will unfold. But Alberta's grievances illustrate legitimate flaws in Canada's system of federalism. A failure to address them would likely cause further rifts between Canada's eastern and west provinces.

More States Enact New Laws Curbing Teachers Unions

QUOTE: New organized labor reforms signed into law by Florida Gov. Ron DeSantis last week require a majority of members to be present for teachers union certification or recertification votes, increase fines for illegal strikes, and establish merit-based pay for educators.

The Teacher Freedom Alliance says more than 272,000 teachers have opted out of union membership.

In Idaho, after July 1, teachers unions will be prohibited from collecting dues directly from members' paychecks, using paid time off for union activities, or recruiting new members during school hours.

A similar law in Arizona, which also bans teacher strikes and prohibits organized labor members from using any school property—even email addresses—for union activities, will be decided on by voters in the November election.

"They can't consume taxpayer-funded resources during the school day," said Russ Brown, special projects director for the Freedom Foundation, a policy organization that assisted state legislators with those measures and helps teachers opt out of union membership.

These ideas are expected to gain ground throughout the nation in the months and years ahead, Brown told The Epoch Times.

Individually, the Freedom Foundation's Teacher Freedom Alliance has so far helped more than 272,535 teachers in red and blue states opt out of union membership, including more than 50,000 in 2025 alone, according to data provided to The Epoch Times.

At the state level, Oklahoma lawmakers have advanced legislation that would allow teachers to withdraw from a union at any time and would terminate "closed shop" provisions that prevent teachers from accessing alternative labor or professional organizations, such as the Teacher Freedom Alliance.

No partisan considerations.

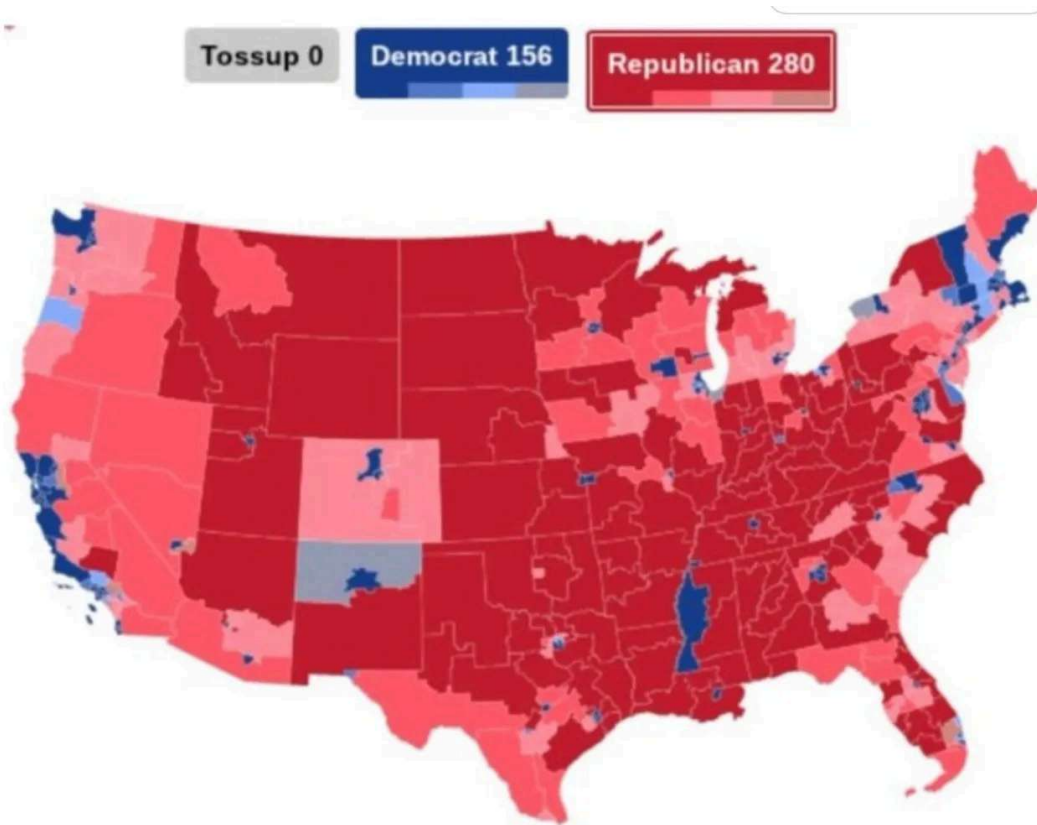
No racial considerations.
