

Senate Votes to Codify Gay Marriage

On Wednesday, the Senate voted to [move forward](#) the Respect for Marriage Act, a bill that will codify same-sex marriage into federal law. The bill was supported by many Republicans in a 62-37 vote, which gave it enough votes to clear the 60-vote filibuster.
